

Junior Hindi Translator

The Syllabus for recruitment to the post of Junior Hindi Translator is outlined below. Written examination will be OMR based and shall be the qualifying examination for eligibility to appear in the Descriptive Examination.

A. Syllabus for OMR based Examination

Part – 1: Paper – I (General Hindi)

50 marks

- (i) Verbal Ability in Hindi comprising of Gramatical Topics i.e., Samas, Sandhi, Kriya, Visheshan, etc.,
- (ii) Hindi Paragraphs,
- (iii) Hindi Synonyms and antonyms
- (iv) Hindi proverbs
- (v) Knowledge of Hindi
- (vi) Operating Hindi application softwares on computer
- (vii) *Official Language Act.*

Part – 2: Paper – II (General English)

50 marks

- (i) Verbal Ability in English comprising of Gramatical Topics i.e. Articles, Preposition, verbs, etc
- (ii) Vocabulary
- (iii) Error recognition
- (iv) Fill in the Blanks
- (v) Sentence structure
- (vi) Synonyms and Antonyms
- (vii) Spellings
- (viii) Correct use of words, phrases and idioms
- (ix) Basic computer applications

B. Syllabus for Descriptive Examination

- (i) Translation of Passage from Hindi to English **20 marks**
- (ii) Translation of Passage from English to Hindi **20 marks**
- (iii) Essay in Hindi **30 marks**
- (iv) Essay in English **30 marks**
